

SOBA Membership Fees and Entitlements

1. Affiliate Member

An Affiliate member has some Ortho-Bionomy® training and uses Ortho-Bionomy in their work or life. The Affiliate member may or may not be interested in further training and may or may not have completed practitioner training. **Annual Fee: \$25**

Entitlements: Listing in the SOBA Directory. Subscription to the quarterly SOBA Newsletter. Access to advertise in the SOBA newsletter (in accordance with the Society's Ethical Guidelines).

2. Practitioner-in-Training (PIT)

A Practitioner-in-Training is enrolled in the Practitioner Training Program with the Society of Ortho-Bionomy International® and the Society of Ortho-Bionomy® Australia. The Practitioner in Training will have completed 112 hours of Ortho-Bionomy instruction, provided SOBA's PIT membership form and submit documentation of continuing education (CE) every two years. **Annual Fee: \$45**

Entitlements: All the privileges of an Affiliate member. Practitioner-in-Training members are only permitted to use the term "Ortho-Bionomy®" in a list of their modalities and invited to contribute articles to the quarterly SOBA Newsletter.

3. Practitioner/Advanced Practitioner

A Practitioner/Advanced Practitioner will have completed the Society's 503 hour Practitioner Training Program or 502 hour Advanced Practitioner Training Program, be registered with the Society of Ortho-Bionomy International® and the Society of Ortho-Bionomy® Australia and submit continuing education (CE) documentation every two years. The Practitioner will be currently practising in Australia or overseas. **Annual Fee: \$70**

Entitlements: All the privileges of a PIT member, registration in SOBA Directory and SOBA website listing. Usage of the term Ortho-Bionomy® and the Sand Dollar logo in accordance with the Guidelines and Procedures of Trademark Use for the Society of Ortho-Bionomy® Australia.

4. Instructor

An Instructor is registered with the Society of Ortho-Bionomy International® and the Society of Ortho-Bionomy® Australia. Instructors have completed extensive training. An "Associate" designation indicates that the individual is in the process of completing the requirements for that instructor level. **Annual Fee: \$100**

Entitlements: All the privileges of an Advanced Practitioner as well as the use of SOBA newsletter and website to advertise their training classes.

NOTE: Continuing Education (CE) Documentation

All renewing PIT, Practitioner and Advanced Practitioners Members must submit proof of 16 hours of continuing education every two years.
